D. POLICIES & GENERAL INFORMATION

General Procedure:

- o Show a Positive Attitude, focus on learning, and show effort in all tasks.
- Accept Responsibility, be friendly and helpful, and treat others kindly.
- o Come prepared for learning and keep your hands and feet to yourself.
- o Take ownership of your actions, Work Together, and choose kind words and actions.
- o Show Respect, listen and follow directions, think before you speak, and act.

Restroom Procedure:

Be quick, quiet, and careful. Flush, wash your hands with soap, and dispose of paper towels in the trash.

Lunch Procedure:

- Parents must provide lunch, snacks, and water.
- Stay seated and talk quietly. Raise your hand for help.
- o Clean your area and dispose of trash when dismissed.

Classroom Procedure:

No activities that could harm yourself or others are allowed; equipment from home must be approved by a teacher or the school director.

E. ATTENDANCE/ TARDINESS:

- Attendance is mandatory. Students must attend school regularly. Parents and students are responsible for contacting teachers about assignments and makeup work for any absences.
- Tardiness: Students must arrive by 10:00 A.M. to benefit fully from our programs. Time management is crucial for academic and professional success. Late students will not be allowed in class until the second period.
- o Parents will be contacted for repeated tardiness.
- o Early Dismissal: A written, signed note by the parent or guardian is required for early dismissal.
- o If a student gets sick during school hours, parents or guardians will be contacted using the emergency phone number provided at registration. They must pick up the child promptly after the call.
 - o In case of an emergency, 911 will be contacted.
 - O Parents are advised to keep their child home from school if they're not feeling well, including symptoms like fever, cough, sore throat, or upset stomach.

Parent Communication:

Keeping parents informed is a priority at our school. We use various communication avenues to share information.

- Announcements during the assembly and after the Zuhr prayer.

In severe weather, the administration will announce Sunday school closures via Group Telegram & text.

DRES'S CODE:

- o Allah revealed in Chapter Al-Ahzab, verse 59:
 - "O Prophet! Tell your wives and your daughters and the women of the believers to draw their Jalabib over their bodies. That will be better so that they are known, so as not to be annoyed. And **Allah** is Ever Oft-Forgiving, Most Merciful."
- All students and staff of the school are required to dress modestly and decently, upholding personal dignity according to practices of the Islamic faith.

→ Students must abide by the school's dress code.

Pove	Full or Half-sleeve shirts and bottoms covering their knees.
Boys	**No above-knee shorts and no backward caps.
Girls	Loose-fitting, full-length garments (choose from Abaya, Isdal, full-length long-sleeved Dress, or Long Skirt) and a scarf covering the head adequately. **No leggings or body piercings**
Activity Time	Students are encouraged to change into suitable clothing for any after-school sports activities.

F. HEALTH and SAFETY:

Safety responsibility is shared between parents, students, and the school.

- Parents and students must follow the instructions of the Parking traffic coordinators.
- Students must stay in the school building during school hours unless permitted to leave with a teacher or adult volunteer.
- Please let the school know if your child has any allergies or health issues that need special care from the teacher.

Students with special medical needs requiring medication (e.g., for asthma or allergies) must have parents available on campus.

Parents' Presence:

Parents are not allowed inside the school or Islamic Center during school hours, with no exceptions except for medical conditions or approved educational purposes. Roaming parents send the wrong message about the seriousness of our school to students.

G. Code of Conduct:

- Students and teachers are in school to promote the Islamic and educational development of students. To achieve this, each student must meet specific disciplinary objectives.:
 - a. Teachers can deduct points for assignments handed in late; homework and assignments must be satisfactory and handed in on time.
 - b. The parents and students are responsible for contacting teachers about assignments and make-up work when a student is absent.
 - c. School Supplies (List Below): Students must come prepared to school. Arriving at school without supplies gives the impression that they are passive participants, and they are merely here to pass the time.

- d. It is a top priority to tutor our students in proper Islamic and civil behavior; students exhibiting negative behavior will receive a consequence.
- e. We model respect for our students with the expectation of reciprocity. All students must be respectful and courteous; disrespect towards staff or students will not be tolerated and will lead to serious consequences.
- f. Horseplay is not allowed in our school; this includes playing, fighting, pushing, shoving, throwing objects, or any behavior that disrupts the regular school day. Violators will be suspended from school.
- g. Staff can direct student behavior, and students must respond appropriately. Failure to do so may lead to discipline or suspension.
- h. Students are not permitted to bring electronic games, toys, personal electronic devices, etc., to school. Violators will have devices taken away and returned to their parents at the end of the day.
- Students must respect school and others' property. Any damage should be reported immediately to a teacher or director. For willful damage or negligence, the student or parent may be responsible for repair costs.

Failure to uphold the disciplinary objectives may result in the following sequence of events:

- Name recorded.
- 2. Referred to the principal.
- 3. No recess privilege (for the older students).
- 4. Parents are contacted.
- 5. Dismissal from school

H. REVISION OF SCHOOL POLICIES:

Sunday School Administration may periodically issue bulletins to announce policy revisions. These will be filed with the principal and shared via email and the WhatsApp parent group, as noted on the bulletin board.

The school policies on the topics discussed will remain in effect. Administrators will use discretion regarding disruptions to the educational environment.
